Kramer, born in 1919 in North Dakota, has cultivated a very unique style and has had a very distinguished career marked by many awards and exhibits. Kramer has been a teacher, exhibit curator and has administered art programs, restored artwork and owned galleries.

A Saint Paul studio has been his base for many years and he is fond of heading to places like Red Wing in search of landscape subjects. Kramer has extensive experience in many types of painting mediums, but works mainly with oil. His works feature outwardly realistic treatment of landscapes, still-life subjects and occasional portraits. In addition to the skilled artistry of his work, Kramer has developed a unique style quite different from conventional realism. Many of his paintings evoke an illusive other dimension that takes them beyond simple realism.
